(Miami, FL) -Mayor Manny Diaz and Commissioner Marc D. Sarnoff will recognize Spirit of Bay Heights and Natoma Manor residents for the **completion of the US1 Wall on Saturday, November 22, 2008** at 10:00 a.m. at the end of Alarka Street and Nethia Drive (Next to 1605 Nethia Drive).

The scope of work includes removing the existing pink wall along US1 and replacing with a new pre-cast concrete barrier wall. Construction will start on SW 17 Avenue heading north towards the Planetarium. The construction cost was \$2.7 million with funding sources from Street Bonds and Transit Half-Cent Surtax.
