Background

Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received seven (7) bids on May 29, 2009 in response to the solicitation of the Dinner Key Marina Mitigation project.


Bidders were required to hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida or a General Engineering license from Miami-Dade County, and must have a minimum of five (5) years experience, under its current business name, in mitigation projects of a similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references for three (3) projects within the past five (5) years. The Bidder must also be capable of self-performing at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the physical construction work.

Findings

CIP has completed its review of the low bidder, Shoreline Foundation, Inc., and has determined that the company is also the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Contract Execution

On December 11, 2008 the City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to execute a Contract for this project in accordance with Attachment A of Ordinance 08-01316, "Economic Stimulus Awards and Agreements." Upon approval, we will commence the process required for award of a contract.
