Background

Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received eighteen (18) bids on October 30, 2009, in response to the solicitation for the Fairlawn Storm Sewer Improvements Project.

Prospective Bidders were required to hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida and/or Miami-Dade County General Engineering License and must have a minimum of five (5) years experience under its current business name, in the construction of similar projects including five (5) separate project references of similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references within the past five (5) years. The Bidder must self-perform at least thirty-five percent (35%) of the physical construction work.

The work consists of the following: South of West Flagler Street involves storm sewer improvements that consist of exfiltration trenches, manhole inlets, cross drains, swale trenches and surface restoration. The work north of West Flagler involves the construction of a storm drain system that connects to an existing culvert at West Flagler Street and NW 50th Avenue to another existing outfall at the intersection of NW 5th Street and 52nd Avenue, leading to the Tamiami Canal. The road improvements for the entire project include but not limited to roadway milling and resurfacing, ADA ramps, repair damaged sidewalks, curb and/or gutter replacement, repair and/or replace traffic signs, re-grade and/or re-sodding swale areas to street blocks impacted by drainage improvement activities.


Findings

CIP has completed its review of the low bidder, Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., and has determined that the company is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Contract Execution

On June 29, 2009, the City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to execute a Contract for this project in accordance with "Attachment A" of Ordinance 13045, "Economic Stimulus Awards and Agreements." Upon approval, we will commence the process required for award of a contract.
