Question	2	The minimum requirements state that the Proposer must have been in business under its current name for at least 5 five years. Is it acceptable if the President of the firm has over five years of project management experience in lieu of the Proposer?
Answer	2	No. As stated in the RFQ, the Proposer(s) must have a minimum of five (5) years experience under its current name and ownership.
Question	3	Are the Project Reference Forms (RFQ-PP-R) needed from each Subconsultant and if so how many for each?
Answer	3	No. Proposers are responsible for completing all forms except the required reference forms. The reference forms are to be completed by the Project Owner and only apply to the Proposer and not the Subconsultants.
