Recommendation

Based on the review and findings stated below, Capital Improvements Program (CIP) has determined that the Project should be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Miami Skyline Construction Corporation.

Background

Capital Improvements Program (CIP) received eleven (11) bids on January 22, 2010 in response to the solicitation for the creation of the Robert King High Park Soccer Field Restrooms project.


Prospective Bidder shall hold, at the time of bid submission, a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida and must have a minimum of five (5) years experience under its current business name, in the construction of similar projects including five (5) separate project references of similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references within the past five (5) years. The Bidder must self-perform at least twenty (20%) of the physical construction work.

The work consists of the following: construction of new soccer field infrastructure, including restroom facilities with lift station, HC parking lot and walkways. The work also includes the relocation of palm trees and utilities, the installation of new sports lighting system and bleachers.


Contract Execution
