**Recommendation**

Based on the review and findings stated below, Capital Improvements Program (CIP) has determined that the Project should be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Horizon Contractors, Inc.

**Background**

CIP received 16 bids on February 5, 2010 in response to Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 08-09-076 for the Kinloch Storm Sewer Improvements Project, Phase I.

Bidders were required to hold a current certified license as a General Contractor from the State of Florida and/or possess a Certificate of Competency issued by Miami-Dade County as a General Engineering Contractor and must have a minimum of five (5) years experience under its current business name, in the construction of similar projects including five (3) separate project references of similar size, scope, and complexity, supported by references within the past five (5) years. The Bidder must self-perform at least thirty percent (35%) of the physical construction work.

The work consists of the following: Phase I consist of exfiltration trenches, manhole inlets, cross drains, swale trenches and surface restoration. Road improvements include but not limited to roadway milling and resurfacing, ADA ramps repair damaged sidewalks, curb and/or gutter replacement, re-grade and/or re-sodding swale areas to street blocks only impacted by drainage improvement activities.



Horizon Contractors, Inc., has successfully completed projects for the City – including the Tamiami Storm Sewer Project.

**Contract Execution**

The City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to execute a Contract for this project in accordance with the current "Attachment A" of Ordinance 13045, "Economic Stimulus Awards and Agreements." Upon approval, we will commence the process required for award of a contract.
