The time to plan is NOW!

June 1st through November 30th is hurricane season and the Humane Society of Greater Miami urges you to prepare now in the event that you will have to evacuate your home because of a storm. It is important for you to plan now to avoid last minute surprise and confusion when a storm is approaching. It is possible to evacuate with your pet if you plan ahead.

Never leave your pet behind!

Your pet depends on you for food, water, veterinary care, exercise, and most of all, to keep him safe! Please take your pet with you! If you are ordered to evacuate, it is because officials are concerned that your home is in the danger zone. Your pet's life may be in jeopardy if you leave him behind.

Importance of identification

It is imperative that your dog or cat wear an identification tag at all times, every day, whether the pet lives indoors or outdoors. Also, the Humane Society of Greater Miami strongly encourages microchip identification for pets, in case the pet's identification tag should become lost. A "microchip ID" is a tiny microchip that is injected under the loose skin between a pet's shoulder blades. Each microchip is encoded with a unique number that is registered in the owner's name in a national database. If your pet becomes lost and is taken to a shelter or a veterinary clinic, the pet can be scanned to determine the microchip number, and then the number can be used to find the owner in the national database. A microchip is NOT a substitute for a regular identification tag, rather it is a back up in case the pet's regular ID tag becomes lost. The Humane Society of Greater Miami offers pet microchipping at a low cost. Call 305-696-0800 for more information. If you don't equip your pet with proper identification and he gets away from you during a storm or any other time, there is a chance that you will never see him again. **Identification is that important!**

If your home is a safe place

If your home is a safe place to be during a storm and officials have not ordered you to evacuate, then you and your pet should probably stay at your home until the storm passes. Hopefully you are prepared and have the supplies you need to weather the storm, including extra food and water and emergency supplies for you and your pets (see checklist). Be aware that pets will sense the change in the weather and changes in your daily routine. He or she may become nervous or stressed, characterized by excessive panting, whining, pacing and/or hiding. Pets, especially dogs, have been known to try and run outdoors after being startled by lightning or other loud noises, as if they are trying to run away from the sound. To help lessen the pet's stress, try to keep his routine as normal as possible (feed him at the same time, in the same bowl, in the same place, etc.) It may be comforting for the pet if you make a special cozy area just for him in a quiet area away from any windows (such as a utility room or bathroom) with a thick blanket to lie on, a few treats and a favorite toy.

If you must leave your home

If you feel that you will not be safe in your home during a storm or if you have been ordered to evacuate, take your pet and go to a friend or family member's home in a safe area until the danger subsides. Be sure to bring the emergency supplies for you and your pet!

If you don't know anyone in a safe zone, you could take your pet with you to a pet-friendly hotel in a safe zone. In advance, select several hotels (outside of the commonly-evacuated areas) and call to confirm their pet policies. Once you are certain that your pet will be welcome there, keep the phone numbers on

hand in preparation for an emergency. Once a storm is approaching, hotels fill up quickly, so be sure to call and make a reservation as soon as you think you may have to evacuate.

My pet is not allowed at the place where I'm going!

If you will have a safe place to go during a storm but you know your pet is not welcome there (for example, Red Cross shelters DO NOT accept pets), ask a friend, coworker, or a relative in a safe zone if they would be able to keep your pet for a week or so until you are able to return home. If you don't know anybody who could take your pet, arrange in advance for your pet to go to a boarding kennel. Remember, homeless animal shelters like the Humane Society of Greater Miami ARE NOT able to board pets for the public (animal shelters typically are already at maximum capacity with the homeless pets they care for on a daily basis). One way to find a reputable boarding kennel is to ask your friends or coworkers to recommend one that they have used. In advance, visit a few perspective boarding kennels and find out what their policies are for emergency situations. Choose the kennel that you feel best meets the needs of you and your pet. Or, ask your veterinarian if he or she offers pet boarding – many do. Most boarding facilities require proof that your pet is up-to-date on their vaccinations. If you need to get your pet's vaccines updated, call one of HSGM's low cost Preventive Health Care Clinics at 305-696-0800.

Whether you take your pet to a hotel, a friend's house or to a boarding kennel, you will need to bring enough pet food and supplies to last your pet for at least two weeks.

Checklist of supplies to have ready for your pet in an emergency

- Properly-fitted collar bearing pet's current license and identification tag
- Leash
- Portable crate/carrier for your pet
- Food and water bowls
- A two-week supply of pet food in a watertight container (a manual can opener may be necessary if the food is canned)
- A two-week supply of clean water (for an idea of how much you will need, remember that large dogs need **at least** ½ gallon of water per day)
- Up-to-date health records including a recent photo of you with your pet
- Your pet's medications – at least a one month supply
- Cat litter pan with cat litter and/or newspapers, litter scooper, and plastic bags for feces disposal
- Toys and healthy treats
- Towels
- First aid supplies (first aid guide, bandages, gauze, adhesive tape, scissors, tweezers, antibiotic ointment, etc.)

Remember, if you are ordered to evacuate, **do not leave your pet behind!**
It is possible to evacuate with your pet if you plan ahead.

Greater Miami-Area Boarding Kennels And Animal Hospitals/Clinics That May Board Pets In a Hurricane

Most boarding facilities, even if not stated here, require owners to provide proof of current vaccinations (typically this means rabies and DHLPP for dogs and rabies, FeLV and FVRCP for cats), food for the pet, a portable crate or carrier, and a fee for boarding. Many facilities have limited space for boarding, and some only allow their clients to board their pets at their facilities. Take the time, before a disaster situation occurs, to choose several boarding facilities you might use in an emergency situation, and then call or visit them to confirm their policies and fees, and to make sure it is the right place for your pet.
