



## CITY OF MIAMI STREETCAR STUDY

### Public Hearing Notice

The City of Miami will hold a Public Hearing for the Miami Streetcar Study on:

Project information will be available for review from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The formal portion of the Hearing starts at 6:00 p.m., including project presentation followed by an opportunity for interested individuals to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed project.

The City of Miami, in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation, is proposing to build the Miami Streetcar Project from Government Center in Downtown Miami to the Miami Design District, and the Civic Center/Health District complex. The project recommends a proposed 10.13-mile urban transit circulator that will operate in existing roadways, and provide connectivity among major activity centers, commercial and retail establishments, as well as residential communities throughout the project corridor.



This Hearing will be held in accordance with 23 CFR 771 and Section 339.155, Florida Statutes. The project is being developed to comply with Titles VI, VIII of the Civil Rights Act. The Hearing will consist of a presentation by the City of Miami regarding the project and its associated impacts followed by a public testimony period. Before and after the Hearing, City representatives will be available to answer questions.
