The Civilian Investigative Panel was established to act as independent citizens' oversight of the sworn members of the Miami Police Department. It conducts investigations, reviews policies and makes recommendations to the city manager and to the police chief.

There are three current openings; one from Commission District 3, one from Commission District 5 and one Mayoral appointment. To be eligible, a person must:

- Be either a permanent resident of the city, own real property in the city, or work or maintain a business in the city
- Have a good reputation for integrity and community service
- Have no record of a felony conviction
- Not currently employed by the City of Miami
- Not a former employee of the City of Miami Police Department
- Not be a current party or party's legal representative in litigation against the city
