CITY MANAGER TONY E. CRAPP, JR. APPOINTS SPECIAL ADVISOR ON PUBLIC SAFETY

(Miami, FL) – January 31, 2011 – Miami City Manager Tony E. Crapp, Jr. today announced that he has appointed a special advisor on public safety to join his staff. Mr. Paul R. Philip, a veteran public servant with over 33 years of experience at both the federal and local government levels, will provide the city manager with the technical expertise necessary to effectively address the wide range of public safety issues in the City of Miami.
