## DINNER KEY MUNICIPAL MOORING FACILITY INFORMATION BULLETIN #5 OCTOBER 14, 2009

### Mooring Facility Opening November 1, 2009

I am pleased to report that we have scheduled to open the Dinner Key Mooring Facility for business on **Sunday, November 1, 2009**. We will be contacting vessel owners who have applied for moorings in the order in which their applications were received, based on length and draft of vessel. For those of you who have applied, we encourage you to call Dinner Key Marina (305-579-6950) or stop by to see where you are on the list. Below are some important details regarding the Facility & our operating policies:

- Our mooring rates will be as follows:
  - Transient Overnight: \$18 per night, plus tax
  - Transient Monthly: \$300 per month, plus tax
  - Annual: \$225 per month, plus tax (add 1 month Security Deposit)
- To be accepted for annual moorage, customers will need to complete and sign a Mooring & Dockage Agreement, Rules & Regulations, provide current vessel registration or documentation, and a copy of current picture identification.
- Until our Harbormaster's Office and other facilities are up and running (across the marina entrance road from the Seminole Dinghy Dock, next to the Expo Center) we will be using Dinner Key Marina's office and restroom facilities for our Mooring Facility customers.
- Our hours of operation shall be from 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM from Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 AM through 8:00 PM Friday through Sunday.
- We will operate a free customer shuttle service originating from the Seminole Dinghy Dock between the hours of 7:30 AM & 5:30 PM from Monday through Thursday, and 7:30 Am & 7:30 PM Friday through Sunday. Schedule for service is currently being finalized.
- Effective November 1, 2009 the Marinas Division will begin active management of the Seminole Dinghy Dock, which will be used as the primary landing and dinghy docking area for Mooring Facility customers.
