



TEEN CLEAN

Spearheaded by Commissioner Spence-Jones, The South Florida Workforce and City of Miami NET Offices have teamed up with the City of Miami's Office of Sustainable Initiatives and Belafonte Tacolcy Center to train youth ages 14-22 as Environmental Outreach Specialists over a 6-week summer program, Teen Clean.

Approximately 30 students from District 5 were selected based on financial need, susceptibility to educational or employment barriers. These youth come from areas imploring for improvement and youth action, and Teen Clean is training them to bring positive assets and environmental awareness to their respective communities.

The youth will spend two days per week providing community service and planning environmental projects throughout their neighborhoods, while spending three days per week in an educational setting learning valuable professional and environmental skills from experts in the field. The program will cover the following topics, to name a few: Health and Wellness, Sustainable Architecture, Native Landscaping, Green Jobs and Economy, Recycling, GIS, Asset-Based Mapping, and Green Transportation.
