Re: Moratorium on Construction Work and Staging within the Public Right-of-Way during Art Miami Week 2016

Dear Utility Owner/Contractor:

Each year, during the first week of December, the Art Miami Week event attracts thousands of art aficionados to the City of Miami, specifically within the Wynwood and Design District areas. The City of Miami is imposing a moratorium on construction work and staging on the public right-of-way within the area bounded on the south by NW/NE 14 St from NW 3 Ave to Biscayne Bay, on the east by Biscayne Bay from NE 14 St to NE 41 St, on the north by NE 41 St from Biscayne Bay to Miami Ave, and NW 29 St from Miami Ave to Interstate 95 (I-95), on the west by Miami Ave from 41 St to 29 St and Interstate 95 (I-95) from NW 29 St to NW 17 St, to accommodate the influx of pedestrian and vehicular traffic expected during that week. **Deliveries and concrete pours are prohibited within the moratorium area.**

The moratorium will become effective starting at 6:00 pm on November 28, 2016, and will continue in effect through 8:00 am on December 5, 2016.

Utility companies will only be allowed to make emergency repairs to facilities. Within 24 hours of said emergency, the City of Miami Public Works Department shall be notified of the nature of the emergency and right-of-way restoration plans. All contractors and utility companies working within the moratorium areas shall demobilize and adhere to the restoration requirements outlined below.

PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE NOTED IN THIS LETTER, ALL PAVEMENT SHALL BE RESTORED WITH HOT ASPHALT PATCH AND ALL SIDEWALKS SHALL BE RESTORED IN LIKE CONDITIONS, I.E. CONCRETE, BRICK PAVERS, ETCETERA... PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE CITY RESERVES ITS RIGHT TO ENFORCE BONDS AND PURSUE ANY VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE DURING THE MORATORIUM.
