**(Miami, FL January 8, 2018)**—In observance of the Christmas Day holiday, City of Miami residents are advised there will be **NO GARBAGE, BULKY TRASH OR RECYCLE PICK-UP** on **MONDAY, JANUARY 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. The Solid Waste Department will be closed and will resume normal operations on Tuesday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018. City of Miami residents should hold their garbage / bulky trash / recycling until the next scheduled pick-up day.

**Residents whose RECYCLE PICK-UP day falls on Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018, are being provided with an alternate recycle pick up on WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**

**Normal service shall resume on Tuesday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and residents are reminded to:**

- Place garbage, recycle carts and bulky trash out in front of their home on the public right of way and away from phones/cable/electricity lines, under trees, utility poles, fire hydrants, fences, vehicles and/or 5 feet away from any structure.

**The City's Mini Dump will also be closed on MONDAY, JANUARY 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**
